WHAT IS OPEN GOVERNMENT?



Open Government is a culture of governance that promotes the **principles of transparency, integrity, accountability and stakeholder engagement**, in support of democracy and inclusive growth (**definition**

contained in the OECD Council Recommendation on Open Government of 14/12/2017).

The **Open Government Forum** is a space for participation and permanent dialogue, made up of a president and sixty-four members, thirty-two representing the Public Administrations and thirty-two representing civil society.

Open Government Partnership

Spain has been part of the Open Government Partnership (OGP) since its creation in 2011. In 2023, Spain has been elected as a member of the Partnership's Steering Committee and, in September, was **unanimously elected to serve as incoming co-chair in 2023-2024, and lead co-chair in 2024-2025**. This election implies the organization of the Global Summit 2025 in Spain.

This multilateral organization, made up of government and civil society reformers, aims to make Government more transparent, collaborative, accountable and inclusive.
